Climbing with Christ Pt 2 Matthew 5:1,2

Mountain moving faith (Mt 17:20) requires mountain climbing faith!

Reflection: God's word clearly teaches that:

1) We're saved by God's Grace through the vehicle of personal Faith!

Eph. 2:8 "By Grace ye are saved, through Faith." (Pistis: persuasion, credence, conviction) (also Ro. 5:1,2)

- 2) "Faith" and "Belief" are not the same thing!
 - ➤ "Believe" in English can mean to either accept (or suppose) an idea or opinion is true. It involves a mental/academic (head) assent.
 - ➤ "Believe" in the Bible (pisteuō) literally means to "trust in and <u>commit</u> to!" It is a matter of the heart, not the head! Ro. 10:10
 - Many have embraced the wrong kind of belief! (See Mt 7:21-23)
- 3) There's a profound difference between being a believer and being a disciple!
- a) "Believer" (Pistos') is found Twice in NT. (Acts 4:14; 1 Tim. 4:12) and it means trustworthy!
 - ➤ Genuine "believers" trust Jesus Christ as their Savior! (They believe he's worthy of their trust!)
 - ➤ Their focus is on "Forgiveness" from Jesus. (What they can "get" from Him.)
- b) "Disciple" (Mathētēs) is found 255 times and it means to learn, understand, and follow!
- These are growing to trust Jesus, not just as savior, but as their <u>Lord!</u> (kureos: supreme authority) (They strive to be worthy of His trust!
- ➤ Their Focus is on Following Jesus! (Fellowship) Jn 10:27
- 4) Christ's clear desire is for us to become growing disciples! (2 Pt 1:5-11)
 - a) The emphasis (or outcome) of Discipleship Is Transformation → Committed Action! Jms1:22; 2:18-20

1st Time the word "Disciple" is found in NT is in Mt. 5:1 "And seeing the multitudes, he went up into a mountain: and when he was set, his disciples came unto him: 2 And he opened his mouth, and taught them..."

While the Multitudes, returned to their respective "comfort Zones", The "disciples" were willing to climb the mountain and so heard the transforming truths about God's Kingdom.

Notice the Process or Development of a Disciple.

1. Curious DESIRE:

- A. We've Met The Master And Want To Know More About Him. Pr 18:1
- B. As is true of our Salvation, God also initiates this invitation / desire. Ps. 27:8; Jn 6:36,37; 44 This "curious desire" should lead us to the place of a:

2. Committed Decision. (To follow Him)

A. We must respond to God's invitation. (Rev. 3:20; Gen. 6:3; Isaiah 55:6; Heb 3:8,15;4:7) This committed decision should produce:

3. A Clear Declaration: Ro. 10:10-12 Faith is personal, but it's not Private! Ps 107:2 "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so..."

A. Of *Intention*.

- 1) Lines are drawn at this point! Exo 32:26 'Who's on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me!"

 And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him."
- a) This decision shaped their Destiny! (The Levitical inheritance!)
- B. Of Allegiance. Joshua 24:15 "choose you this day whom ye will serve" (See also 1 Kings 18:21)
- 1) God doesn't want secret servants! Jn 19:38,39 "after this Joseph..., being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, ...And there came also Nicodemus, which ...came to Jesus by night..."

Desire → Decision → Declaration, but they will all be fruitless without:

- 4. A Committed *Dedication*.
 - A. As we follow Jesus through Crises, our desire, decision, declaration will be tested!
 - 1) After ministering to the Multitudes Jesus "gave commandment to depart unto the other side" Mt. 8:18
- a) Although several thought about joining him, only the disciples got in the boat! (Mt 8:19-23) While the multitude chose the safety of the shore, the Disciples followed Jesus into the Storm...
- B. As we follow through Crises, our Desire, Decision & Declaration Will be rewarded!
- a) They experienced the power and peace of Christ's Presence! Mt 8:26-27
- C. We need to count the cost and be willing to pay it! (See Mt. 8:19-22)

"Success always has a price and it must be paid in full and in advance." H.L. Hunt Heb 10:36 "ye have need of patience, that, after you've done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

38 Now the just shall live by faith!"

- 1) Being a "believer" costs us little more than our Pride and our trust.
- 2) Becoming a disciples may cost us everything! After Jesus spoke of the importance of "counting the cost" he said "So likewise, whosoever he be that forsaketh not (Apotassōmai: arranges in order) all that he hath, he cannot be mu disciple." Luke 14:33
- 3) The Crises of life are the Crucibles through which God proves and purifies our faith And "pushes" us through this process! Job 23:10 "He knoweth the way that I take, when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold..." (See also 1 Peter 1:7; Ro. 8:28,29)

Conclusion: The process of Discipleship involves a:

- 1) Curious Desire "That I may know him..." Ph 3:10
- 2) Concrete Decision "what things were gain to me, I counted loss for Christ..." Ph. 3:7
- 3) Clear Declaration "I follow after..." vs 12
- 4) Committed Dedication. "I press toward the mark for the prize of the High Calling of God..." vs 14
 Where are you in this Process? Where do you truly want to be?

Or are you more like the crowd that Paul described in Vs 18,19?

"For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:

Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind (focus on) earthly things."

Application: Our Decision, Declaration & Dedication Will affect our Destiny and inheritance! Mt 16:24-27

"If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels;

and then he shall reward every man according to his works."

(Not according to his beliefs!)
