MAKING YOUR LIFE COUNT Or "Planned for God's Purposes"

Guided Growth with Pastor Keith @ CBC Sunday, Aug 30

Satan knows we're "Shaped for Significance" (Gen. 1:26; Jer. 29:11; Jn 10:10; Rev. 4:11) and seeks to sidetrack us from finding and pursuing the path that will lead to lasting Peace and Purposes. (Contrast Pr. 14:12& Ps.16:11) The very nature of sin is to sidetrack us from God's purposes. This is often fueled by: Callousness (Hardness) Mt 13:19; Conflict (Pressure) Mt 13:20-2;1 Contamination/Clutter Mt 13:22; and Carelessness/ Complacency (Acts 24:25; 1 Pt 5:8)

God's purposes revealed in the Great Commandment (Mt. 22:36-40) remind us:

- > We're planned for God's Pleasure. (Loving Relationship with God / Worship) Rev 4:11
- > We're formed for Fellowship. (Loving Relationship with others) Eph 1

God's Great Commission reveals that God's Great Plan involves our: 1. Salvation: Mt 28:19; Luke 19:9,10

- > This establishes a personal relationship with God. (Jn 1:12; 2 Cor. 6:18)
- This enables the power & Presence of God's Spirit. (Gal.4:6; 1 Jn 4:4) Salvation is actually about our <u>RESTORATION</u>. (Col. 1:13; Eph. 2)
- 2. Baptism: Mt. 29:19 (Baptizo: "to dip, make fully wet" used in each case)
 - ➢ Is an act of obedience. 1 Pt 3:21; Mt 10:32
 - ➤ Identifies us with Jesus. (Ro. 6:3,4)
 - Identifies us with Christ's Church. (Acts 2:41,42)
 Baptism is ultimately about our <u>IDENTIFICATION</u> (With Christ and His Church)

The third dimension of this "Great Commission" equips us to *"walk in newness of life"*. Ro 6:4

3. Discipleship: Mt. 28:20 *"Teaching them to <u>observe</u> (tereo: to guard, value, watch, keep)* all things whatsoever I have <u>commanded you."</u> (Entellomai': from en: from a fixed position and telos: to set out for a definite point or goal!)

A. Discipleship is the process whereby

- 1) We Grow to <u>understand</u> God's Goals/Will. (2 Tim. 2:15; 3:16;17) 2Ti. 3:16 "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine...That the man of God may be perfect, (ar'tios: renewed, complete, mature) thoroughly furnished unto all good works.
- 2) We grow to value God and His will and so choose to adjust our lives accordingly! (Mt 28:20; Acts 4:42; Jms 1:22-25; 1 Jn 5:3)

B. The Point (goal) of Discipleship is Personal *Transformation!*

Ro 12:1-2 "present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, (agathos: beneficial) and acceptable, (euar'estos: fully agreeable, pleasing) and perfect, (telios: complete, mature, the goal) will of God." (thelema: purpose, pleasure)

Mt 10:24,25 "The disciple is not above his master, nor the servant above his lord.

It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord."

Disciple: μαθητής (mathētēs) literally means a learner or pupil.

- 1) This Was God's Original Plan. Gen. 1:26 *"Let us make man in our image,"* a) Not "God" But "*Godly*" (Like God) See 1 Peter 1:15,16
 - (1) Heb. 1:3 tells us that Jesus is the *"the brightness of his glory, the <u>express image</u> of his person"* Charakter': a replication, exact copy
 - (2) Jesus reveals the <u>Character</u> or God! (Jn 10:30; 14:9; John 1:14 "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

God's image (in/through) us has been marred by sin... But can <u>restored</u> in us through Grace and Truth! (Eph. 2; Phil 2:13)

- b) God Wants His Children To Grow Up To Become Like Him. 1 Peter 2:2 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:" (2 Pet 3:18)
- (1) Babies are blessings; unless they refuse to grow up! Heb 5:12,13; 1 Cor 3:1-3
- (2) He uses "all things" to accomplish this. Ro. 8:28,29
- 2) This is the essence of the word "Christian". Christianos': a *follower* of (Like) Jesus Christ
- 3) This is the goal of Discipleship! Not knowledge, but <u>*Transformation!*</u>
- Acts 11:26 "a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch."

Conclusion: God's Great Plan involves your:

Salvation: Responding to "the gospel!" <u>Restoration</u> of a Personal Relationship with Him. Baptism: Public identification and <u>Association</u> with Him and His church.

Discipleship: Orientation/Education/ to enable you to grow (<u>Transformation</u>) "into the image of His Son" (Ro. 8:29)

What does a Mature Christian look (act) like? Like Jesus!

- 1) This is a lifelong Process called Discipleship! Mathētēs': A learner, follower! Just as it takes years for a child to develop the characteristics of their parents, It takes time, training, and tenacity to develop the qualities of Christ.
- 2) This is the 3rd part of the Great Commission: Mt. 28:20 "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you." This is part of God's "Co-Mission" (Mt 11:28-30) "take my yoke upon you and learn of me"
- 3) This is what "abiding in Christ" is all about! Jn 15:1-4 This allows the "Fruit of the Spirit" To develop in our lives! Gal 5:22-24
- 4) The results (fruit) of discipleship (maturity) is ultimately <u>Reproduction</u>! The Fruit has the Seeds for more fruit! Jn 15:16 "I have chosen you, and ordained you, (tithēmi: to place and appoint) that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain!"

Application: John 10:10; Mt. 13:

- What's the "thief" using to distract you from God's Great plan for your life? (Pride, Pressure, Preoccupation (with lesser things) Passivity?
- Jn 10:10...27 "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me!
 - > Will you purpose to learn to "listen" for and to His voice?
 - > Will you choose/purpose to "Follow" Him. Pr. 3:5,6
